(CRE –NAIOP SoCal 2009-2010 Fellowship)**

Fellowship Description & Criteria

The 2009-2010 CRE-NAIOP SoCal Fellowship is a merit based fellowship comprised of two components:

- 1) A \$7,500 financial award which will be paid in the form of tuition reimbursement (applied directly towards student fees whenever possible) over a period of 3 quarters beginning fall quarter 2009

AND

- 2) The opportunity to either:
 - A. Serve as an intern with the NAIOP SoCal Board of Directors, which recognizes the Fellow's amount of time may be limited based on school and possible work schedule
 - Or,
 - B. Serve as an intern with a NAIOP SoCal member company and/or mentee with some leaders of NAIOP SoCal member companies. Details will be discussed with candidate after acceptance.

This Fellowship will be awarded to the best candidate meeting the following selection criteria*:

1. The candidate should be an incoming Full-Time or second year Fully Employed MBA candidate (for 2009/2010 only, third year Fully Employed MBA candidates may also apply)
2. The candidate should demonstrate a strong interest in pursuing and excelling in a career in commercial real estate*

*This criteria will be determined by reviewing the candidate's admissions application which will take into consideration his/her undergraduate GPA, GMAT score and work experience. Current GPA for students enrolled in the FEMBA Program will also be considered. An updated resume and an additional 1 page essay describing why the candidate feels they should be awarded the fellowship must also be submitted for consideration.

Candidates must complete the 1 page essay and updated resume and submit via email to the Full-Time MBA Office to Jhchu@merage.uci.edu or Fully Employed MBA Office to czingare@merage.uci.edu by the end of day September 1, 2009. Applications will be reviewed by the respective MBA Program Office and the Center for Real Estate. A short list of finalists will be established and interviewed by the Academic Director of the Center for Real Estate Development. The fellowship recipient will be announced by October 15, 2009.
